What is a Teacher Grant?

CASE Credit Union was founded in 1936 by Lansing Educators. More than 80 years later we remain committed to supporting educators in the classroom. Our grants are geared for teachers in the Lansing School District, who work every day to bring new and innovative learning experiences to their students. 20 teachers in the Lansing School District will be awarded a \$250 grant.

Who is eligible to apply?

Entrants must be the designated teacher/educator of the classroom that will utilize the grant, and meet the following requirements.

- Must be a current Lansing School District, K − 12 teacher
- If awarded, must open a CASE Credit Union account, if not already a member
- Sign Media Release
- Agree to partner with the CASE Education team to host financial literacy lessons
- Check will be made out to principal of the school for b/o
- Application was complete when submitted

What can the grant money be used for?

Recipients can use grants to fund materials, equipment, and other resources necessary to carry out a project that would otherwise not be covered by the school's budget.

How do I apply?

Teachers can apply for a grant by completing a form that includes:

- Their name
- Their phone and email
- Classroom description

- School name & address
- Principal's name/contact
- An essay detailing how the money would be used if awarded. (max word count 500 – 1 typed page)

Applications can be submitted by mail, emailed to communityeducation@casecu.org, or delivered to any CASE branch. Once submission period closes, grant team members will review all submissions. ALL applicants will be notified of whether they will be receiving a grant.

Do I have to be a CASE Member?

Non-members may apply, but must become a CASE Credit Union member if selected as a grant recipient.

- Agree to partner with the CASE Education team to host financial literacy lessons
- Check will be made out to principal of the school for b/o
- Application was complete when submitted

All information must be received by the September 30, 2018 deadline for the teacher to be considered for the grant.

The Grant Committee of CASE Credit Union will select award recipients and notify all applicants by November 1, 2018. The grant checks will be delivered to teachers at a predetermined time.
